John of Brienne 1148-1237
French Crusader; m. daughter of Conrad of Monferrat and Isabella, heiress of Jerusalem. He became King of Jerusalem and regent during the minority of Baldwin II. He could be predecessor of our Bryans, (not documented).

WILLIAM THE CONQUORER 1027?-1087
KING OF ENGLAND
illegitimate. m. Matilda, daughter of Baldwin, Count of Flanders.

HENRY I, 1088-1135
KING OF ENGLAND
m. Edith (later called Matilda). Daughter of Malcolm III, King of Scotland.

BALDWIN II KING OF JERUSALEM; died 1131.
Cousin and successor of Baldwin I.

Mellisenda
Daughter of Baldwin II; m. Faulk 1092-1143, Count of Anjou, king of Jerusalem.

MATILDA 1102-1167
QUEEN OF ENGLAND
m. Geoffrey Plantagenet 1113-1151; Count of Anjou.

HENRY II, 1133-1189; KING OF ENGLAND;
m. Eleanor of Aquitaine c. 1122-1204; Henry and Eleanor had 8 children; Eleanor became "The Grandmother of Europe" through the marriages of her children. (Eleanor was previously married to Louis VII, King of France; bore him two daughters before divorcing).

m. Joan Fitzgerald in 1549 - Ireland. Joan was Dowager Countess of Ormand, widow of James Butler. She is thought to have poisoned Francis so she could marry a cousin.

Sir Francis Bryan II; 1549?- Ireland
Ireland, raised by Fitzgerald family; Called Prince Bryan; m. Anne Smith, Ireland.

William Smith Bryan
exiled by Oliver Cromwell to Virginia in 1650.
m. Catherine Morgan (11 sons 3 daughters).

William Bryan 1685-1789
brother to Francis Bryan III

Francis Bryan III 1630-1693
returned to Ireland to claim father's land; exiled to Denmark. m. Sarah Brinker, cousin to William of Orange. Was standard bearer for William in Irish "Battle of the Boyne". Returned to America.

Morgan Bryan, Sr. 1671-1763
b. in Denmark; m. Martha Strode 1719-1747. (See Strode Lineage).

Morgan Bryan Jr. 1729-1804
m. Mary Forbis b 1751; accompanied Daniel Boone to Kentucky

George Bryan b, 1758
m. Elizabeth Ragan 1781; Revolutionary War soldier and Indian fighter. Surveyed with his uncle, Daniel Boone through Kentucky. Helped establish Bryan Station.

Melinda Bryan 1797-1872
m. Abraham Todd 1792-1835. Todd's descend from Scotland, Abraham brother to Robert Todd, father of Mary Todd Lincoln.

Eliza Todd 1820-1900
cousin to Mary Todd Lincoln. m. Stephen Ferrel II 1815-?, Stephen in Civil War, Co. K 12th Wisconsin Volunteers, age 54.

John Thomas Ferrel I
1841-?. m. Martha Susan Costley Civil War, Co. K, 12th Wisconsin Volunteers. Marched with Sherman through the Carolinas and to the Sea. In Grand Review of the Grand Army down Pennsylvania Avenue at Wars end.

George Sherman Ferrel 1870-1959
m. Elizabeth Pettit 1881-1941. Homesteaded in Montana.
